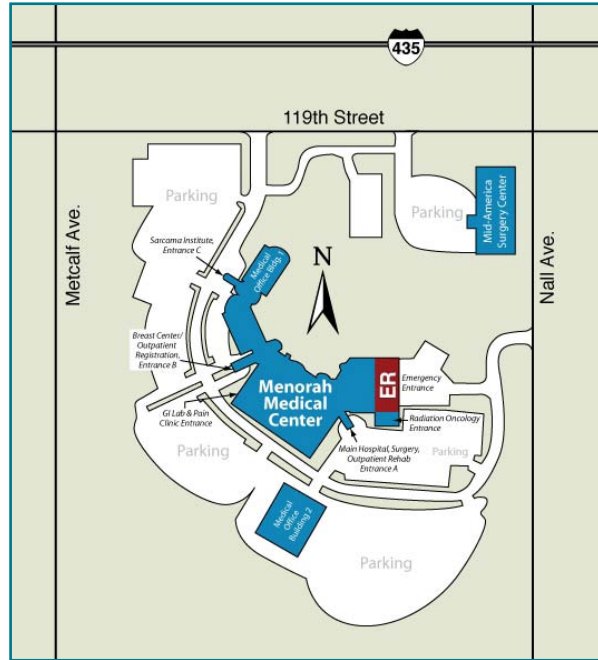

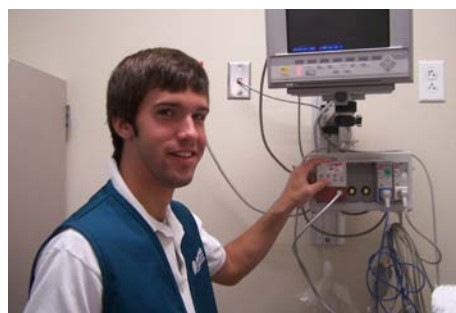

Who are Menorah Volunteers?

Our volunteers represent neighborhoods throughout Overland Park, and possess a variety of skills and abilities that make them wonderful assets to Menorah. Ranging in age from 14 to 91, Menorah volunteers are friendly, helpful individuals dedicated to providing superior customer service.

What Are The Requirements?

- Complete an interview with the Volunteer Manager.
- Submit to a background check and TB test.
- Volunteers must be able to work one four-hour shift from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. or 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. each week.
- Volunteers are required to be in full uniform when on duty. The uniform consists of a green vest and name tag. You may not wear jeans, shorts or open-toed shoes.
- Volunteers must be over the age of 14. Parents, please encourage your children to contact the Volunteer Manager directly.
- Volunteers are required to record their hours electronically. This requires minimal computer skills. Training is available.
- The volunteer program is an ongoing commitment.

Volunteer Attendance Policy

As a volunteer, Menorah Medical Center expects that you will be available during your assigned shift. Your department will depend on you as if you were an employee. If you are sick or have an emergency and are unable to cover your shift, we ask that you contact the Volunteer Manager to report an absence.
